

School Board nomination - Parent Representative

Thank you for considering nomination to our School Board. The School Board is an essential and influential component of our school community. It is made up of an equal representation of staff and parent representatives and supported by community representatives.

The nomination conditions and process for parent representation is as follows:

- The principal will assume the role of returning officer for this process;
- All parent community members have the right to nominate;
- A school newsletter announcement of a vacancy will preclude the nomination process and state a timeframe for nomination;
- Nominations can be received within this timeframe by individual parents or those co-nominated, (co-nominations must be accepted by the parent nominated, preferably in writing to the principal);
- A 100 word limit from the nominated parent representative is received by the principal within the promoted time frame stating why they should be considered for the vacancy. No images should be submitted;
- Should more than one nomination be received for the same vacancy, the principal will inform each applicant and a public election process overseen by the North Metropolitan Education Office will be conducted;
- Both successful and unsuccessful nominees at the conclusion of the election process will be contacted by the principal before existing school board members and the wider school community are informed.
